KICKS OFF: THE EUROPEAN LIFE WOLFALPS EU PROJECT coordinated actions to improve wolf-human coexistence in the Alps

The wolf population is expanding across the Alps regardless of Provincial, Regional and State boundaries: the presence of this predator therefore requires action to improve wolf-human coexistence that is coordinated on an international scale and effective at a local level.

For the first time the LIFE WOLFALPS EU project mobilises bodies and institutions from Italy, France, Austria and Slovenia: a European team that will work from 2019 to 2024 to mitigate the impact of wolves on livestock farming in the mountains, to strike a balance between the world of hunting and the presence of predators, to combat poaching and monitor wolf-dog hybridization and to publish correct information based on scientific data.

The working group is made up of 19 partners, including institutions and public bodies. It is coordinated by the Alpi Marittime Protected Areas, supported by 5 co-financers and over 100 supporters. The goal is to improve the coexistence of wolves and people living and working in the mountains, in collaboration with the stakeholders concerned by the presence of this species, primarily breeders' associations, hunters' associations and environmentalist organisations. An institutional and super partes approach to bringing the results of the previous LIFE WolfAlps project (2013-2018) to a truly pan-alpine level.
